

Stonefield Endowment Trust Fund

The Stonefield Endowment Trust Fund was established in 1984 to generate revenue for the support of activities and facilities at Stonefield Historic Site. Such support is necessary to supplement what regular sources of income do not or cannot cover.

The Trust Fund seeks to obtain contributions from individuals, private foundations, public agencies, and business organizations. All contributions are tax deductible (per IRS 501 (c) 3)

Contributions are added to the body of the trust unless designated for a specific purpose by the donor. Earnings from the fund are used to finance projects which, ultimately, enhance the experience of history provided at Stonefield Historic Site.

There are many ways to give to the Trust Fund:

- An outright gift of cash, stocks, bonds or other equity equivalents.
- Name the Stonefield Trust Fund as a beneficiary in your will, trust, or annuity.
- The gift of a life insurance policy.
- The gift of a highly appreciated asset.
- A charitable remainder trust which allows you to make a gift while receiving income from that gift.
